Dr. Ahmed Mostafa Abdelghaffar is a cofounder and partner of A2G2 design office and consultant firm, which has been involved in multiple architectural/urban and interior design projects over a period of nineteen years. In addition to his practical field of expertise, Dr. Abdelghaffar is an Associate Professor at the Department of Architecture, Faculty of Engineering Cairo University, and a former Part-time Lecturer of Architecture at the American University in Cairo (AUC) and at the Department of Architecture in the Arab Academy for Science, Technology and Maritime Transport Cairo Branch.

His professional experience in the field of Architecture extending over the past twenty eight years has spanned multiple facets of this field; from perfecting the details of interior design, the completion of a large number of diverse types of architectural projects as well as planning and urban design projects, to supervision and execution of multiple residences and administration buildings. Dr Abdelghaffar brings a very unique experience as he has held leading roles in both industry and academia. Before founding A2G2 along with Professor Dr Ali Gabr, he worked in reputational firms and with respectable and prestigious figures on multiple projects varying in typologies

After the foundation of A2G2, the diverse scope of work and reputational participation in the field continued with administrative buildings (for example Complete Design for several office buildings in KSA, Riyadh), landscaping and Urban Design (for instance Architectural and construction drawings for prototypes of the Concordia residential compound for the 'Jesuite school alumni association' in 6th. October city), historical renovation and conservation projects (including Development and planning for Dahshour Pyramids area), health care projects (such as the participation of Complete Design for Sir, Magdi Yacoub Cardiac department in Aswan hospital), and a large diversity of residential buildings and grand villas and palaces both interior and exterior. Furthermore, Dr. Abdelghaffar has been involved in winning several architectural competitions, for instance, third prize winner for an Architectural and Urban Design Competition of the Academy of Judges, Ministry of Justice, 6th October City, in 2003, and second prize for an Architectural Design Competition of Al-Shaikh Jaber al-Ahmad Mosque, Kuwait, 6th October City, in 2011.
